Front bimini tie down strap instructions

Description of issue

Purpose / Scope

These instructions are for the proper installation for the front bimini straps. Please look over the text and picture for the proper placement and adjustment for traveling.

Warning:

Bimini and boot should be removed and strap applied if traveling long distances.



Installation of straps

Slide the loop end in the eye of the tube and then put the female buckle thru and pull

Step 1



Pull tight as shown so the strap will have no slack at the joint.

Step 2



Place the strap over the outer most corner of the canopy and adjust the contact pads to eliminate chafing. Notice how they bend and the proper locations.

Step 3



Put the buckle together and cinch the buckle strap tight. (Make sure the bimini has the trailing legs down and the top lowered and timed out.)

Step 4



Double check the contact pads placement after the hard cinch to assure they did not move, adjust as needed. (*bimini and boot should be removed while going long distances.*)

Installation overview



Make sure the cinch around the top is adjusted properly with the strap around wear pads are on contact points as shown in below pictures.

Pictured below is the proper alignment and installation for the port and starboard front bimini straps.
